Every facet of Craig's restoration of his highly optioned Jeepster was first class.

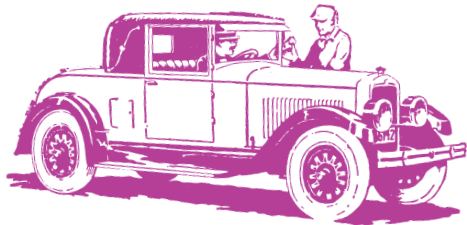

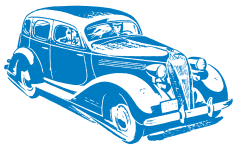
